Jacques Silber is Professor of Economics at Bar-Ilan University, Israel. He holds undergraduate degrees in International Relations, Demography and Economics from the University of Paris. He received later a Masters degree and a Ph.D. (1975) in Economics from the University of Chicago. He has been teaching at Bar-Ilan University since 1975 and has held various visiting positions (University of Connecticut, Southern California, Geneva, Nice, Aix-Marseille, Coimbra, University du Maine and U.C.L.A.). He is the editor of a *Handbook on Income Inequality Measurement* (Kluwer) and the author with Y. Flückiger of *The Measurement of Segregation and Discrimination in the Labor Force* (Physica-Verlag). He is also the Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Economic Inequality* (Springer) and of a book series entitled *Economic Studies in Inequality, Social Exclusion and Well-Being* (Springer). He published more than 80 articles in international academic journals.
