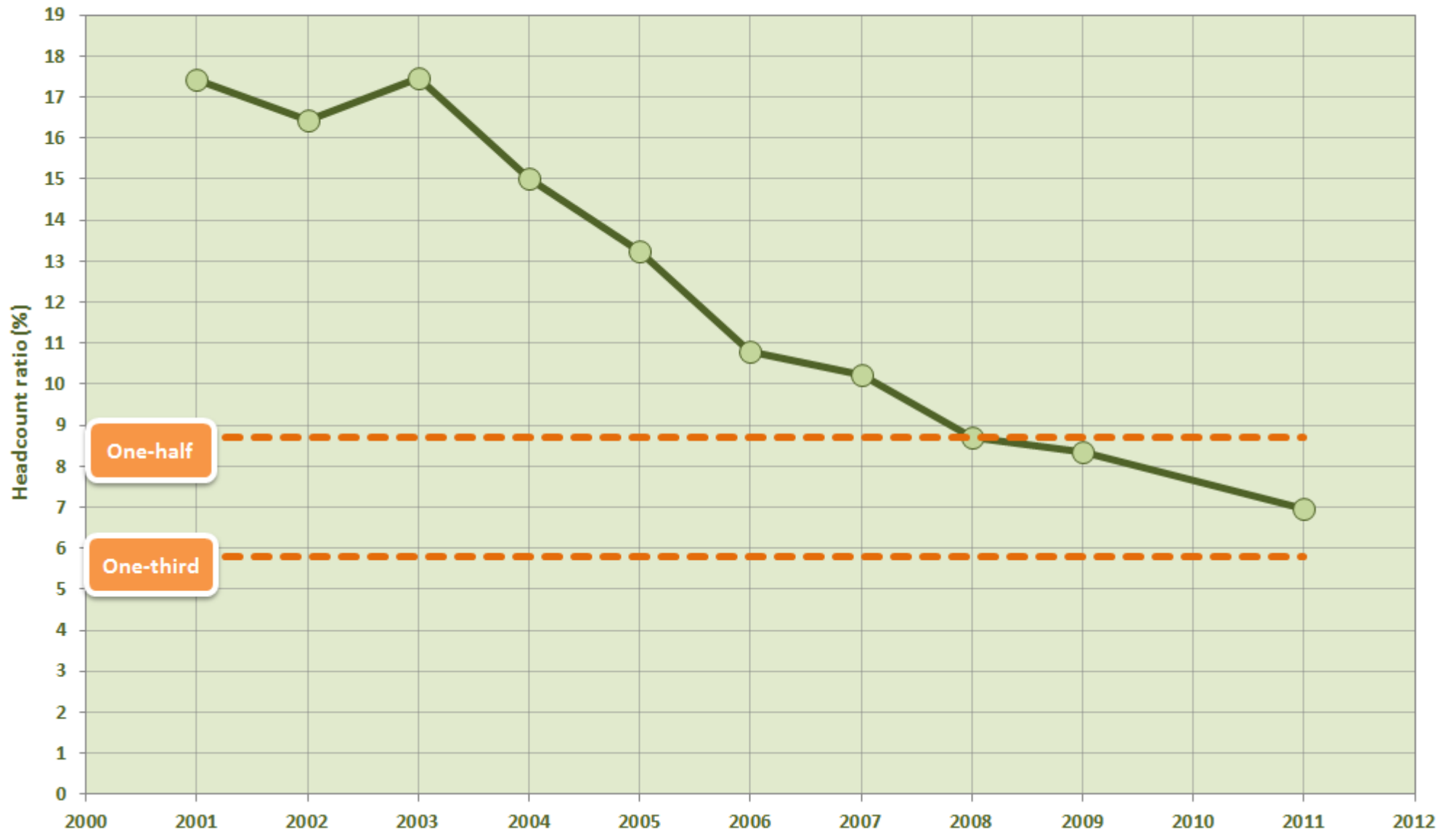


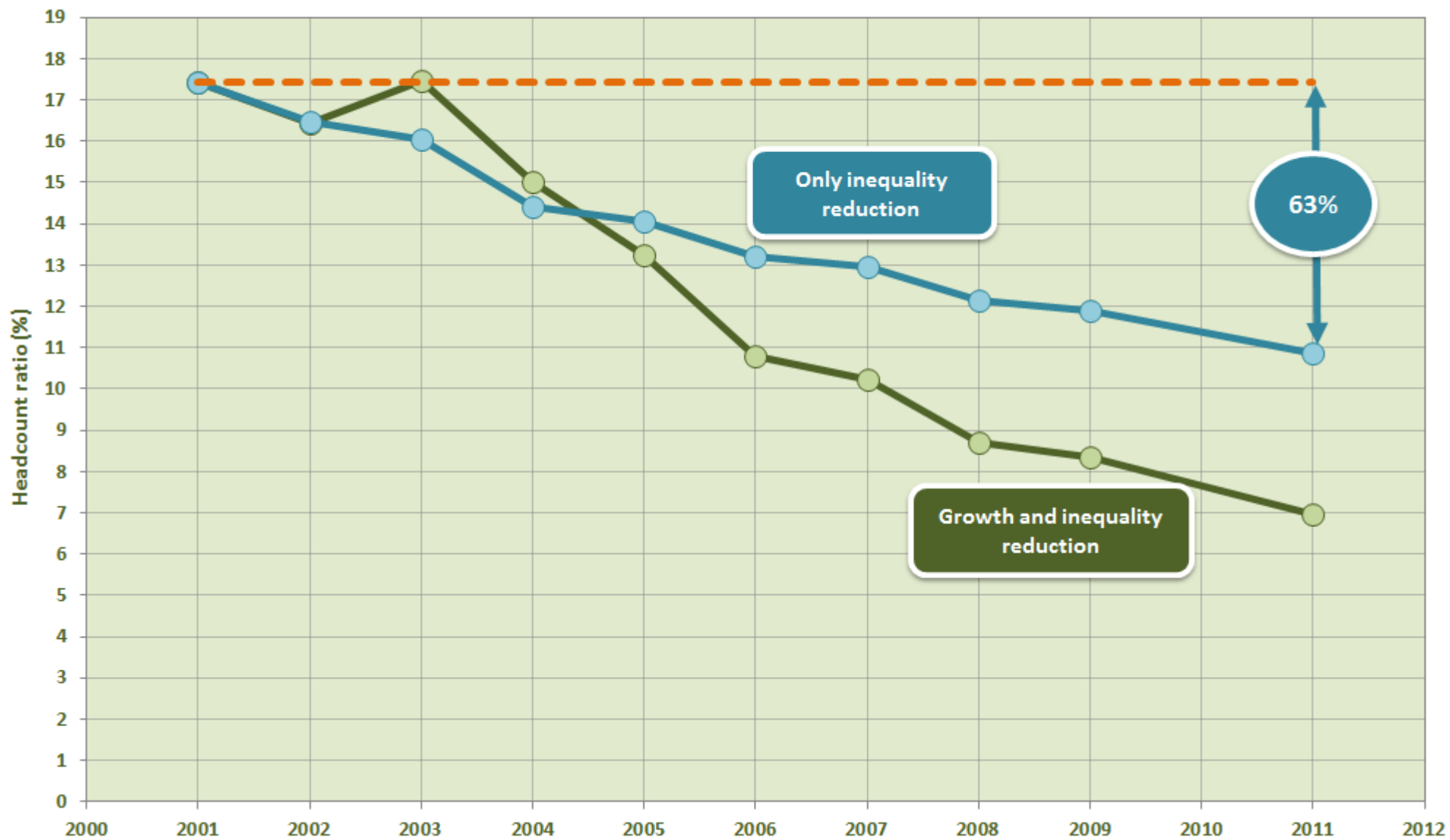

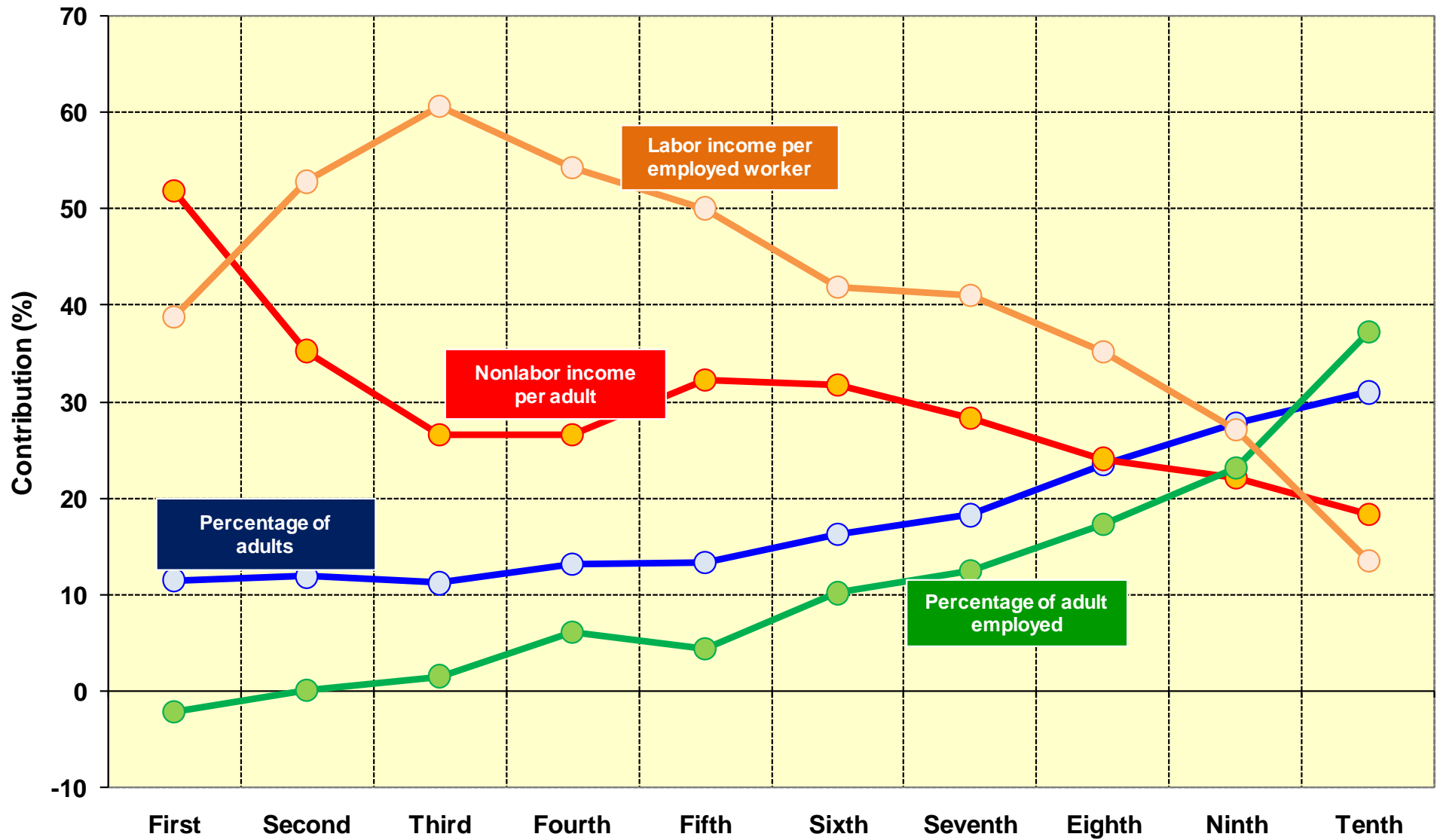
## Evolution of Extreme Poverty in Brazil



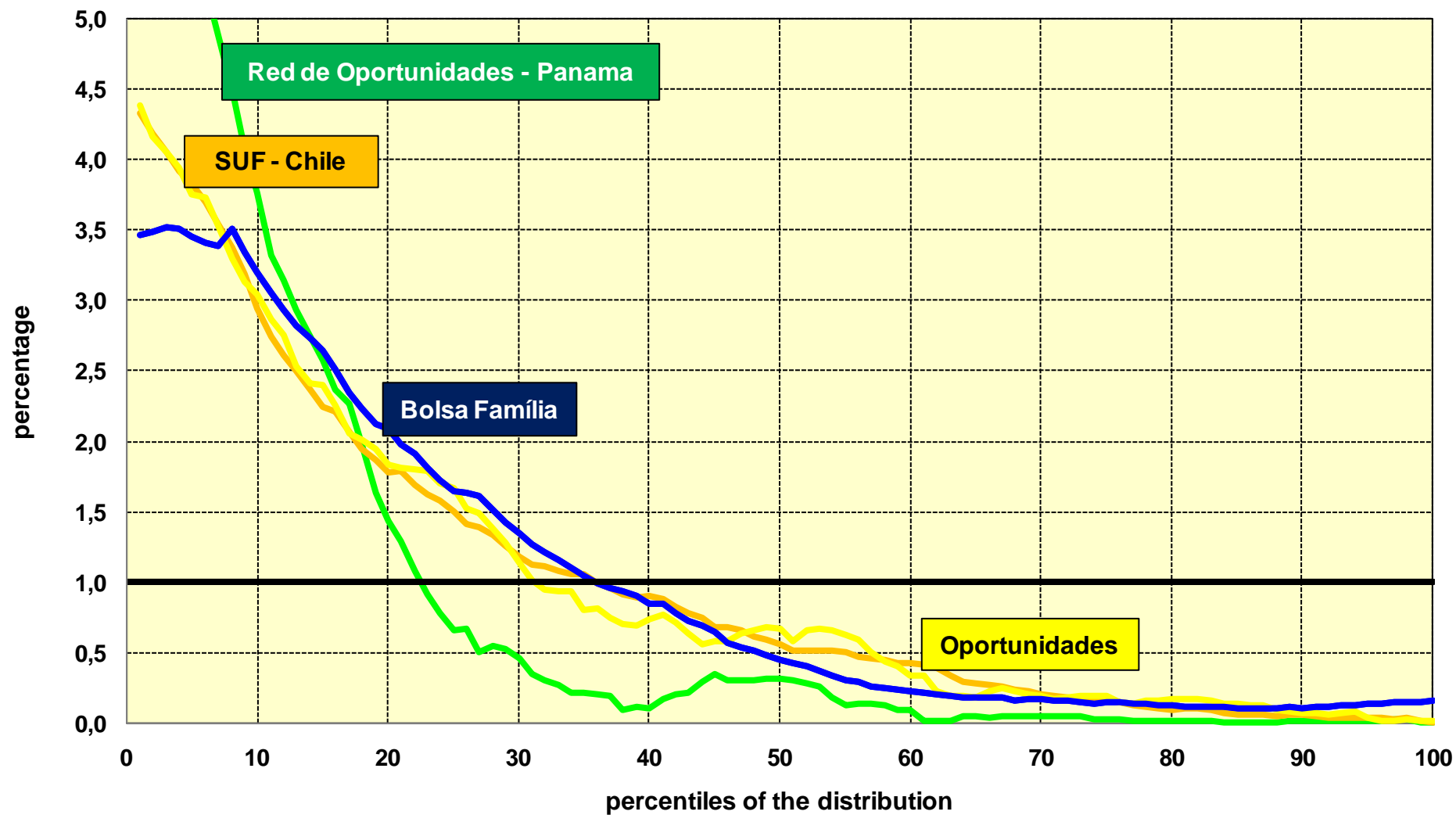

## Per capita income immediate determinants contributions for growth by tenths of the distribution: Brazil, 2001-2009

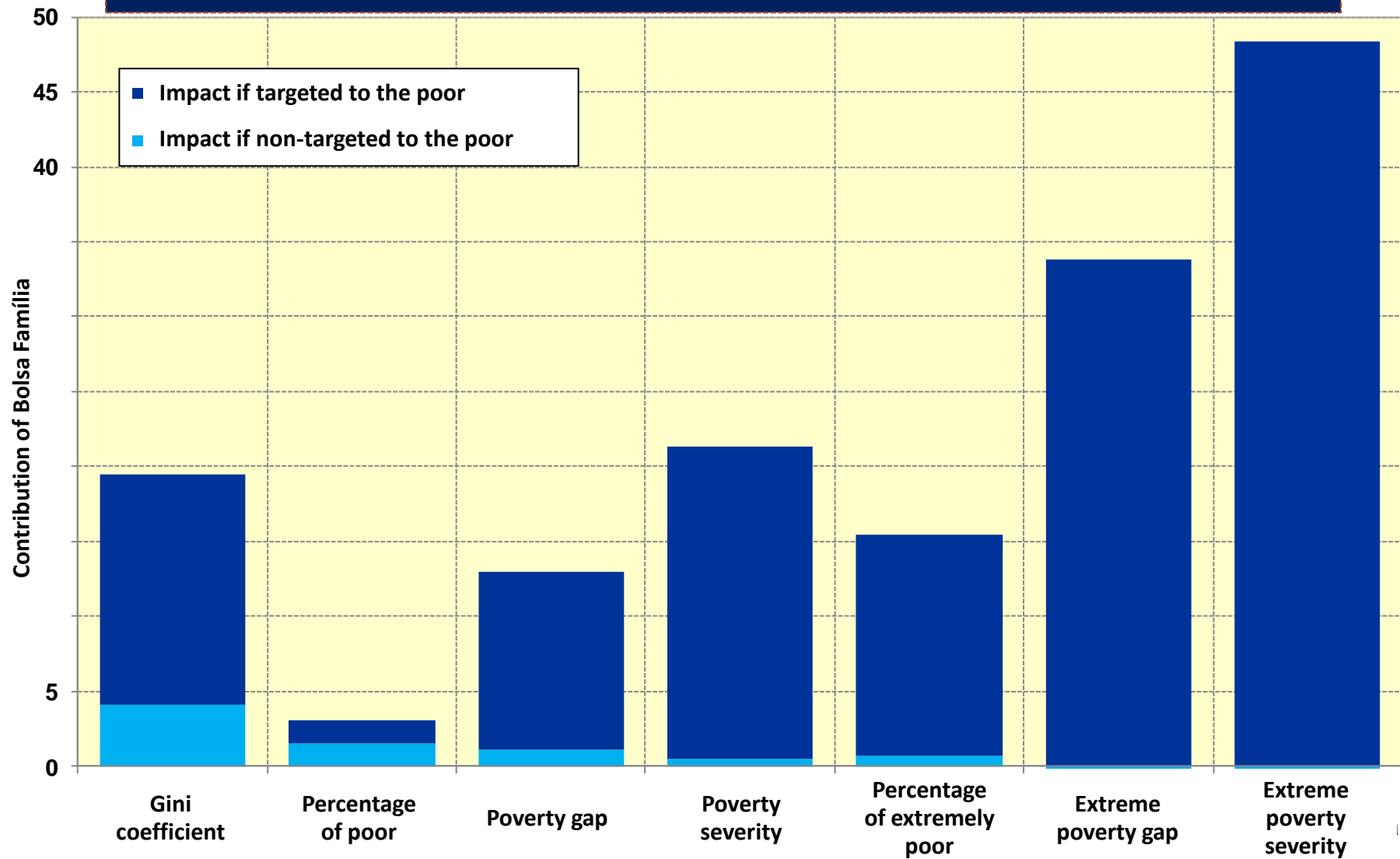


## Distribution of Bolsa Família beneficiaries by percentile of the distribution of per capita income: Brazil



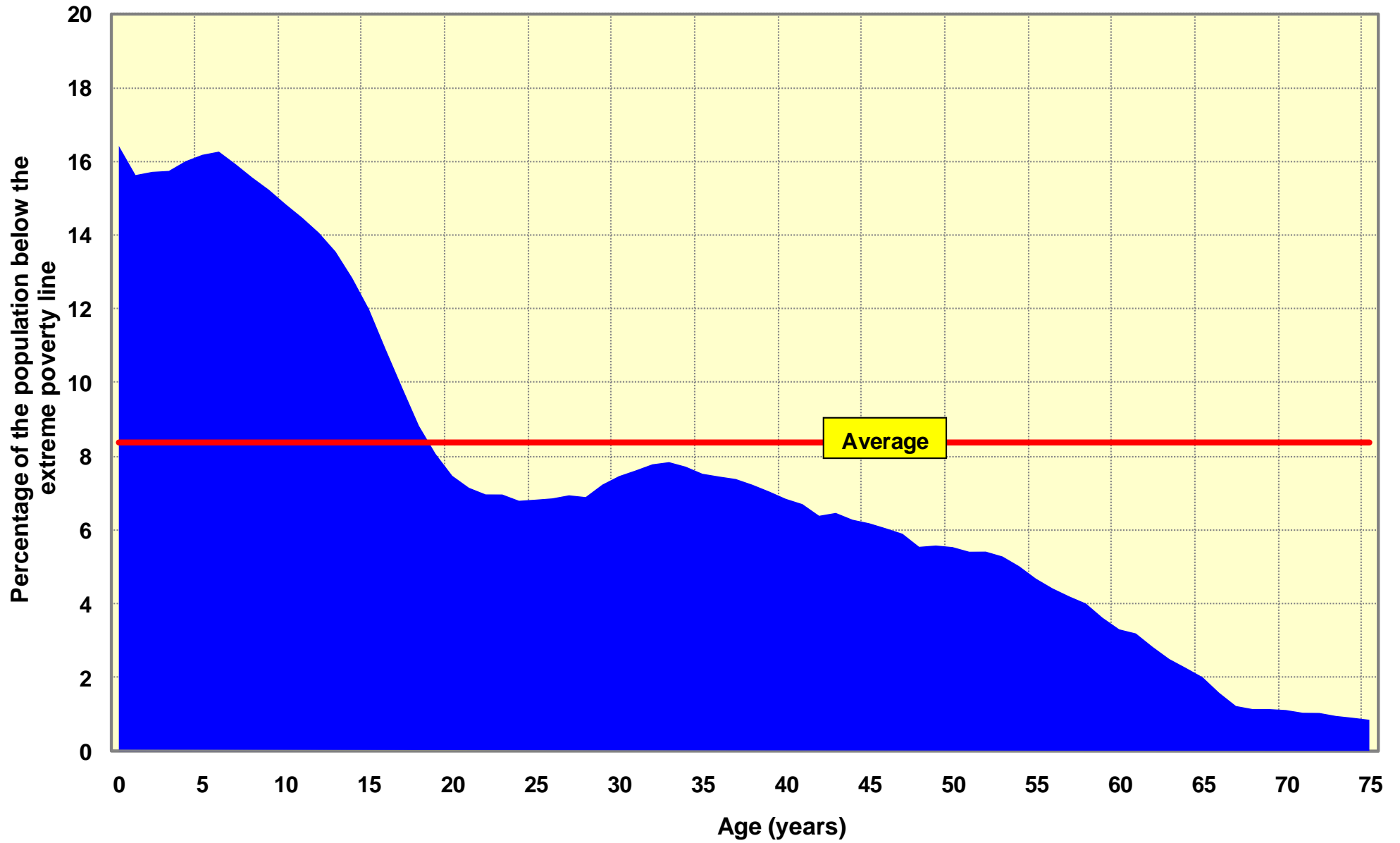
